

Further Information for Kokatha Common Law Holders in relation to the
Mt Gunston Substation Expansion.

The expansion of the Mt Gunston Substation is part of the construction program which will occur for the OZ Minerals Electricity Transmission Line. To allow the expansion to occur ElectraNet will be granted a lease for the expanded area by the State of South Australia.

Infrastructure to support the transmission of electricity will be located in the expanded Mt Gunston Substation area. A fence will be erected by ElectraNet around the area which will mean that Kokatha Common Law Holders will not be able to access the area.

ElectraNet have now advised that the terms of the lease will suspend rather than extinguish the native title rights and interests. In effect this means that the native title rights and interest will be suspended for the period of time that the lease is in place but will revive at the end of the lease term. The life of the electricity transmission line is 50 to 70 years and the lease period for the Mt Gunston Substation will be for a similar term.
