CHILDHOOD EDUCATION APPLICATION INFORMATION

KOKATHA CHARITABLE TRUST

The Kokatha Charitable Trust was established to hold funds received from the Commonwealth Department of Defence as compensation for the activities proposed to be undertaken on the expanded Cultana Training Area. The Kokatha Charitable Trust now distributes a percentage of funds earned by the Kokatha People Native Title Compensation Charitable Trust.

The trustee for the Kokatha Charitable Trust is Kokatha Holdings Pty Ltd (“the Trustee”). The Trust exists to make distributions for charitable purpose to Kokatha People.

All Kokatha people are invited to make application for assistance with Childhood Education expenses.

Applications may be submitted from 29th January until 1st March 2019.

Applications will not be approved if alternative avenues are available, including other Trusts and Government grants.

Useful Hints:

One application to be submitted per child.

Ensure you have a complete application.

Ensure you have a full and complete quote by an approved provider/supplier. The quote or invoice should be issued in your name NOT in the name of Kokatha Charitable Trust.

Note: Once an application is lodged with the Kokatha office there is no capacity to alter or make changes to your application. All applicants will be notified by phone or email once the application has been considered.

The processing and payment of applications will be done as soon as possible. Members can only make one (1) application per child per calendar year for education purposes.

EDUCATION

The aim of this program is to provide assistance with the education of Kokatha children and youth. Applications will be accepted from a parent or guardian of the Kokatha child or youth.

Early Childhood & Primary School

Funding to a maximum of \$500 (including GST) per child for the 2019 school year may be used for:

- Education costs
- Uniforms
- Books and materials
- School excursions
- Any other educational activity deemed by the trustees to fit the charitable objectives. Sporting activities **will not** be considered.

Secondary School

Funding to a maximum of \$700 (including GST) per child for the 2019 school year may be used to cover expenses associated with:

- Education costs
- Uniforms
- Books and materials
- School excursions
- Any other educational activity deemed by the trustees to fit the charitable objectives. Sporting activities **will not** be considered.

NB: Funds will not be provided to replace any Education government benefit or funding program. Cash payments and reimbursements to applicants will not be made.

Decisions

This document shall be used as a guide by the Trustee in relation to distribution from the Trust. The Trustee decision in relation to any distribution from the Trust shall be at the absolute discretion of the Trustee. The Trustee has no obligation to provide any reasons for any decision it makes in relation to distribution but at all times will endeavour to act in a sensitive manner within the confines of its legal obligations to administer the Trust appropriately.
